HEADLINE: TikTok star LilHuddy cheated on Charli D'amelio



TikTok Sway House members Bryce Hall and Josh Richards made a diss track on March 20 to Chase Hudson (a.k.a. Lil' Huddy), suggesting that he cheated on his then-girlfriend Charli D'amelio.

The Hype House and the Sway House are the two big TikTok houses filled with the top creators. The Sway House is made up of six TikTok boys who also occasionally make YouTube videos. Hall and Richards are members of the Sway House and recently posted a diss track about Hudson, one of the creators of the Hype House, on Richard's YouTube channel.

Hudson and D'amelio are a part of the Hype House and began hanging out around late December 2019. On a side note, Charli is 15 years old and Chase is 17 years old. In the beginning, fans just saw it as Hudson hanging out with D'amelio to get more followers because D'amelio, the most

followed person on TikTok, as of April 2020 has 50.1 million followers and Hudson sits at 18 million.

When D'amelio met Hudson, she had about 1 million followers. Hudson had a bit more followers at 6 million, but as they started to spend time together, it appeared he was gaining followers just from having D'amelio in every other video.

They began to post pictures of each other hugging and were spotted holding hands in Target at the beginning of January. They were also seen kissing on New Year's Eve. On Valentine's day, it was pretty much made official with D'amelio posting a picture of them kissing at Disneyland, solidifying their couple status.

Sway House and Hype House didn't really have any drama with each other, until now. On March 20, Richards and Hall released the single "Still Softish," accusing LilHuddy of direct messaging Richard's girlfriend, Nessa Barrett. It was stated that Hudson sent an explicit photo to Barrett, and Richards found out. It was also said that he tried to hook up with her even though he was dating D'amelio at the time.

In one of the lyrics, Bryce raps, "We ain't doing this for the bands. We doing this just to tell all your fans. You still be f\*\*\*ing with girls and telling people Charli's your world?" On TikTok, girls have come forward, saying that they knew Chase in high school, disclosing that he would be talking to a bunch of girls at the same time. For now, at least, this remains speculation.

In the video, they rap about Chase being a toxic person who is just trying to get clout from D'amelio, and after he turns 18, he is going to leave the group. They also brought up a memory from the past when Hudson was punched in the face and broke his nose, then sent a Snapchat to a girl he was talking to at the time, saying the N-word.

At the beginning of the video, they show a fake picture of Hudson sending an explicit photo to Barrett. Additionally, they rap he is small in a certain area and is "Still Softish," hence the track name. To go along with the diss track, the two released merch with pants saying "Still Softish" in the front.

After the diss track was released Hall and Richards went to the Hype House to settle the beef. One of the Hype House members, Nick Austin, called the two saying that they want to talk about the video. As a result, Richards and Hall went over the Hype House and they sat down with Hudson to show him the video. He seemed to not care, saying, "Yo, that's kind of sick it looks like one of the Travis Scott music videos." Then after showing the video, they made a TikTok together and wrote that the beef is squashed.

On March 29, Richards and Hall released an explanation video to the diss track. In the video, they talked about a video that Richards didn't mean to publish on a YouTube video from January that talked more about the Hudson drama that Jaden Hossler, a Sway House member, told D'amelio that Hudson was trying to hook up with Barrett, Richard's girlfriend. Hudson then got mad at the Sway House boys, which made him unfollow all of them on Instagram. Jaden said that he did this because Hudson was mad that he got caught cheating on D'amelio.

In the video, they also talked about when they went to the Hype House to talk to Hudson, saying that it was the most awkward video they have ever filmed. They also explained that they are happy that the drama is over because they have the same friends group. Some people in the Hype House are friends with people in the Sway House. They did this to bring back diss tracks. They both feel that it will still be awkward with Chase, but they wanted to be mature and let people in the Sway House hang out with people in the Hype House.

After the whole debacle, D'amelio and Hudson broke up on April 13. The two went on to Instagram and posted a story sharing statements that they are not together anymore and wish the best for each other. Now, in D'amelio's post, she stated that "I'm sorry I waited this long to tell

you all," which made it seem like they broke up some time ago. From her TikTok account, the last time they made a video together was at the beginning of March, which was before the diss track was made.

From all of this, fans have learned that Hudson does not seem like the nice guy he portrayed on social media; the Sway House has even said that he treated D'amelio badly, but she was so young that she didn't really understand what he was doing to her. More drama is likely on the horizon with the Sway House and Hudson, as this beef appears far from squashed.
